NARNIA HAS RETURNED TO WARLEGGAN

Thanks to the mysterious craftsman who has not only replaced the "Twinned with Narnia" sign on the green by the Chapel but also fixed one to the Warleggan sign at the top of the village. Do enjoy your trip through the wardrobe.

WHERE HAVE ALL THE BELLS GONE?

An inventory of 1551 recorded that there were 3 bells hanging in the tower of St Bartholomew's Church at Warleggan. There was a spire on top of the existing tower and this was struck by lightning on March 14 1818. The spire fell down onto the church causing much damage to the interior. It is believed that at this time two of the bells were sold to contribute towards the repair costs leaving us with the one bell which dates from 1718.

THE WARLEGGAN PROPERTY MARKET

- * **The Rookery, Warleggan** – former 6 bedroom rectory in 3 acres gardens with planning permission as a holiday caravan or chalet site – 1967 - £3,000.
- * **Part Rivermead Farm** – 50 acres of pasture and woodland – 1971 - £5,400.
- * **Mount Pleasant Farm** – farmhouse, buildings and 55 acres – 1965 - £6,400; 1975 - £49,500 (by this time it had been converted into an 8 bedroom guesthouse).
- * **The Schoolhouse, Mount** – 1954 - £350; 1972 - £15,000.
- * **Downhouse, Warleggan**, house and 19 acres – 1968 - £5,250.
- * **Lower Tor, Warleggan** – cottage and 4 acres – 1970 - £6,250.
- * **Barleysplatt, Pantersbridge** – cottage and 22 acres – 1972 - £17,500. 2009 – 6 bedroom house and 10 acres with asking price of £575,000.
- * **Pixie Nook, Warleggan** – one bedroom unmodernised end terrace cottage and garden – 2007 - £131,000.



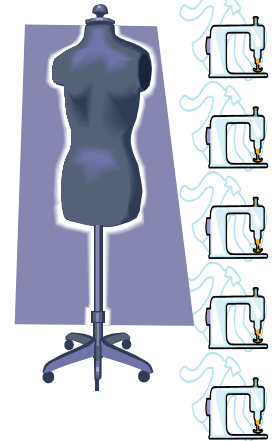
